


### Annual growth rate of GDP





### Volume indices of exports and import





### General government deficit





### Financing of general government deficit (in percent of GDP)








## Savings and net position of enterprises (in percent of GDP)






# Movements of the Forint within the intervention band








# Polish, Czech, Hungarian three-month-Euro yield differential
