- POLAND AS THE BIGGEST RECIPIENT OF THE STRUCTURAL ASSISTANCE 2007-2013 59,6 BLN EURO. ABSORPTION OF THE EU FUNDS WILL HAVE A PROFOUND IMPACT ON THE SHAPE OF THE ENTIRE EU COHESION POLICY.
- THE NEED OF THE COMMON AGRICULTURAL POLICY AND LISBON STRATEGY INTEGRATION INTO THE EU COHESION POLICY.
- OPTIMAL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL VISION OF DEVELOPMENT NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY 2007-2015 (GROWTH-EMPLOYMENT-COHESION)

USE OF EU FUNDS IN POLAND 2004 – 2006*)

- OVER 60 THOUSAND PROJECTS IMPLEMENTED WITH THE FINANCIAL PARTICIPATION OF THE EU FUNDS, INCLUDING 124 LARGE PROJECTS (COHESION FUND)
- THE VALUE OF CONTRACTS SIGNED WITH THE BENEFICIARIES 26 BILLION PLN (ALMOST ¾ OF THE ALLOCATION FOR POLAND IN YEARS 2004-2006)
- THE VALUE OF PAYMENTS FOR BENEFICIARIES AMOUNTS TO ALMOST 6 BILLION PLN (16,9% OF THE ALLOCATION FOR POLAND IN YEARS 2004-2006). EXPENDITURES OF THE COHESION FUND BENEFICIARIES AMOUNT TO OVER 1,35 BILLION EURO

INITIAL IMPACT OF THE COHESION POLICY IN POLAND

Macroeconomic effects

It is estimated that in 2005 structural funds have contributed to both: increase in nominal GDP by 0.86 percentage point and to reduction in the unemployment rate by approx. 0.5 percentage point.

In 2006 their impact on nominal GDP may amount to 2,8 percentage points with simultaneous reduction in the unemployment rate by 1.5 percentage point.

Reduction in development distance between Poland and the EU.

Between 1997 and 2005 Poland reduced the said distance – defined as the GDP per capita at PPP - by about 6 percentage points.

The convergence has accelerated following Poland's accession to the EU: In the period 2004-2005 the development distance was reduced by 2,8 percentage points (the same as in years 1997-2003)

However, other EU new member states have been even more effective in this respect (e.g 11 percentage points in Hungary and 9 percentage points in Slovakia)

Good governance and social effects:



Impact of the EU funds on basic macroeconomic categories - forecast

- EFFECTIVE ABSORPTION OF THE EU FUNDS IN THE 2004 -2006 AND 2007-2015 PERIOD MAY RESULT IN THE ACCELERATION IN THE AVERAGE RATE OF GDP GROWTH IN YEARS 2006-2015 BY 0,67 PERCENTAGE POINTS YEARLY.
- GOALS SET OUT IN THE FORECAST ARE POSSIBILLE TO ACHIEVE SINCE THE FAVOURABLE STRUCTURE AND SPATIAL DISPERSION OF PROJECTS IN THE LIGHT OF MAIN OBJECTIVE OF THE NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2004-2006 (IMPROVEMENT OF COMPETITIVENESS OF POLAND).
- THE INCREASE IN A NUMBER OF PROJECTS IMPLEMENTED BY ENTERPRISES IN RELATION TO THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PROJECTS AS WELL AS THE ACCELERATION IN DELIVERY OF MAJOR INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS IS THE CRUCIAL CONDITION FOR ENHANCEMENT OF STRUCTURAL CHANGES.


Impact of investments co-financed by EU funds on Polish economy Forecast 2006-2015
